When night falls on the savannah, the animals go to sleep. But Littlephant... still wants to play!





THE MOUSE WHO ATE BOOKS






"This is our house. It is very big! But it's not as big as my love for you."

A picture book to tell kids that nothing is bigger than the love we feel for them.







WE LOVE YOU, TEACHER


