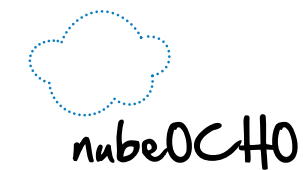

Greta wanted a pet more than anything in the whole wide world...



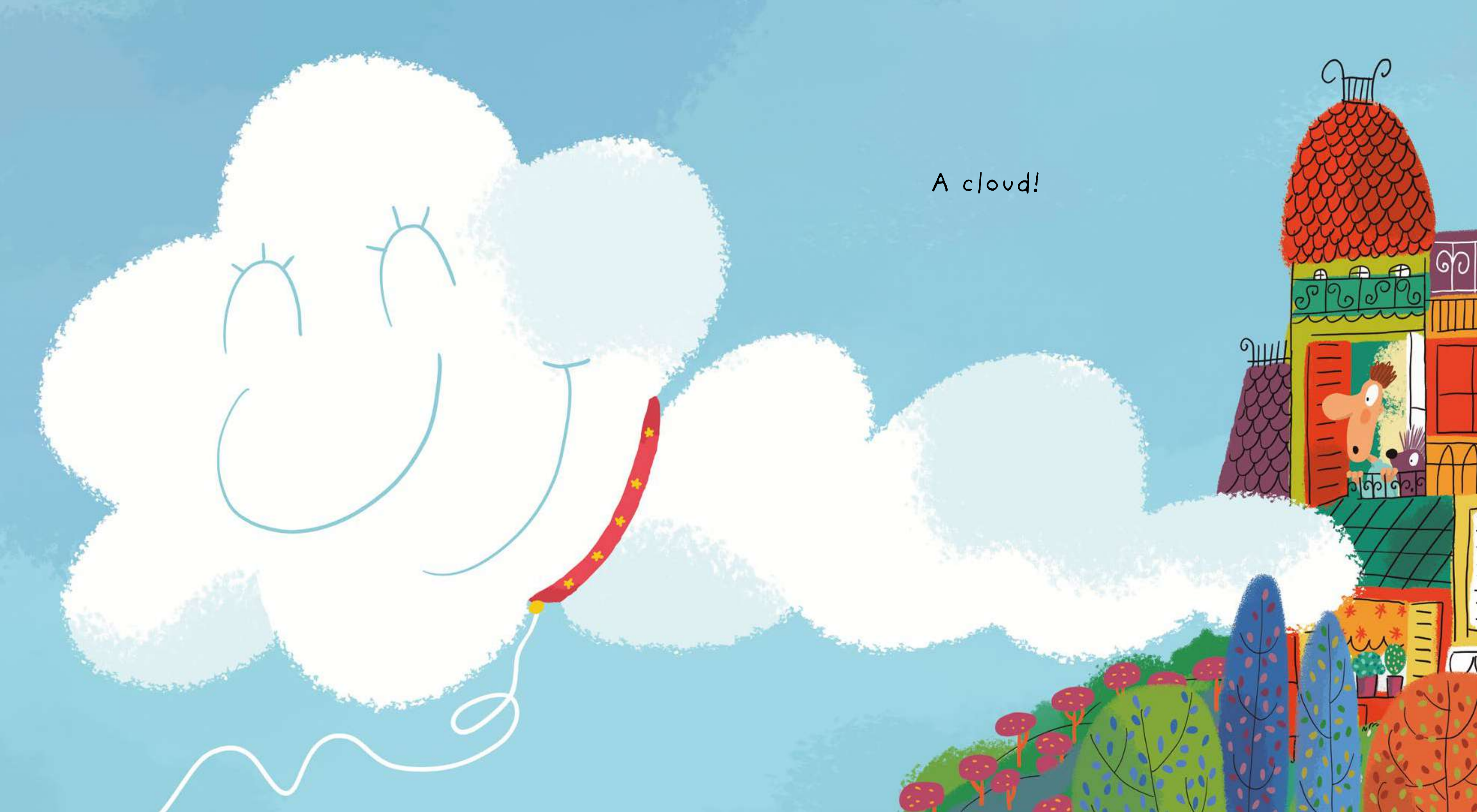


But Greta was allergic to every kind of animal.

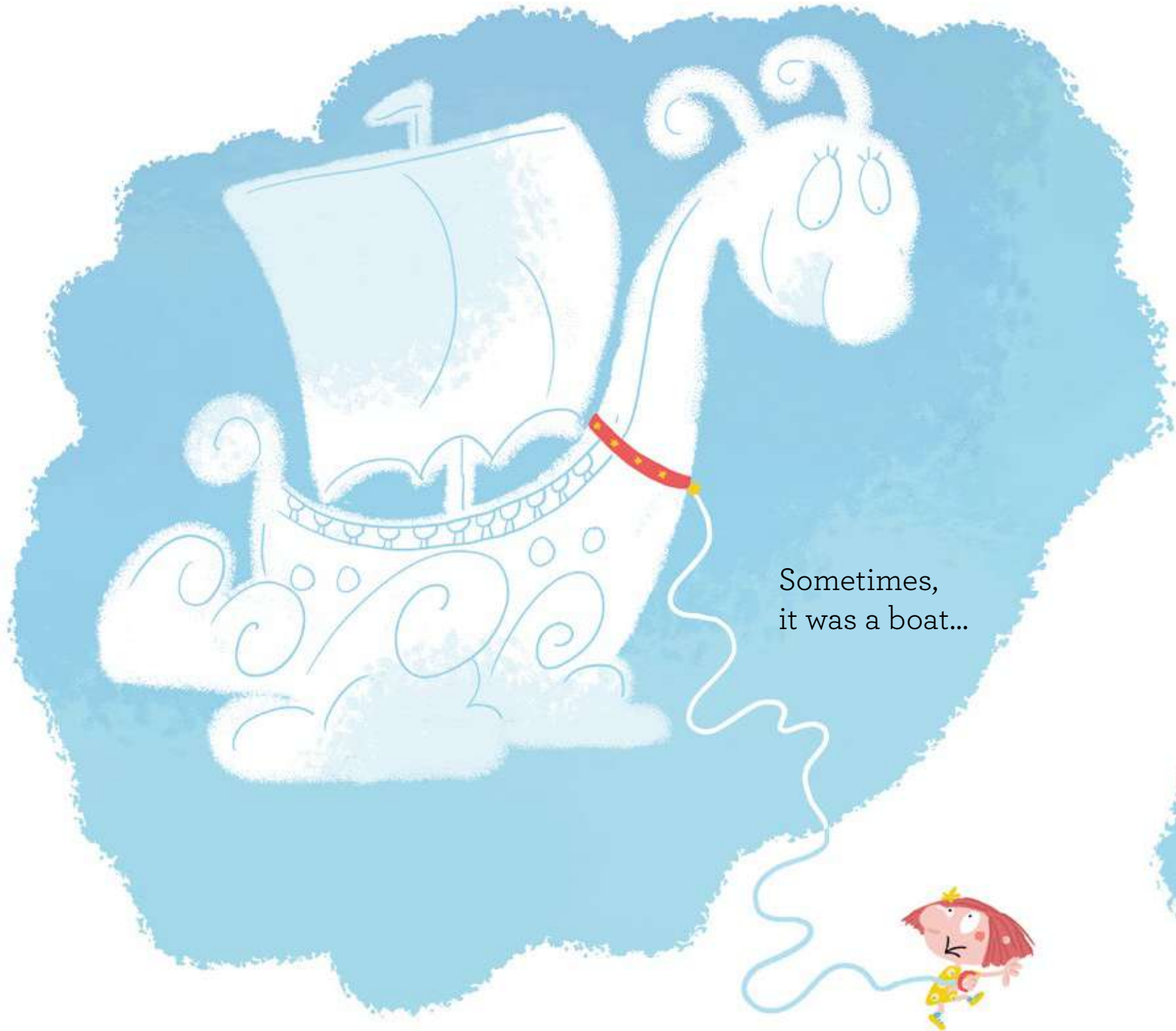
Nevertheless, she still dreamed of having a pet, and one day, she finally got one...



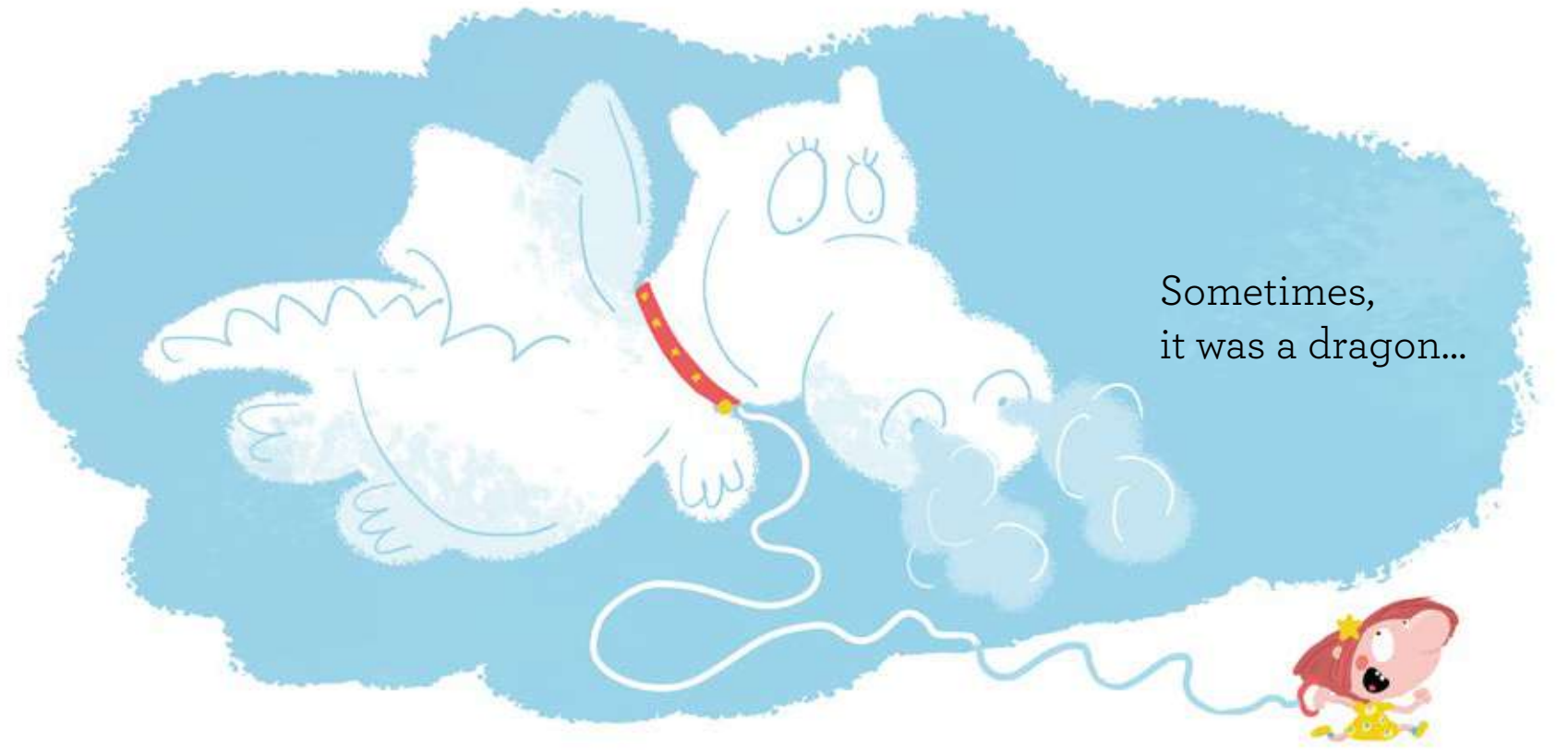
A cloud!

And like most clouds, it was always changing its shape.

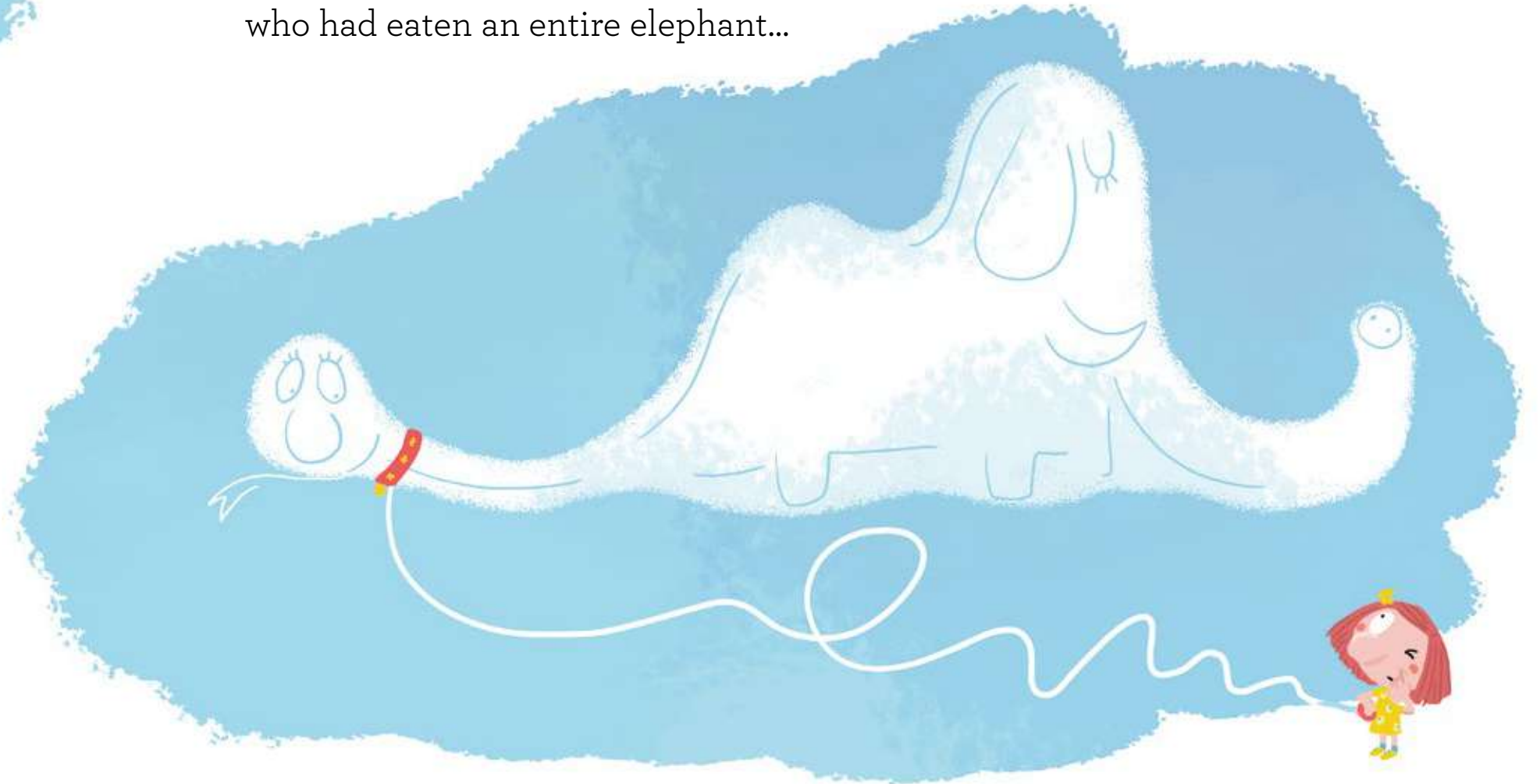


Sometimes,
