# WHEN THE SUN GOES DOWN







Imaginations will run wild, and the ending delivers room for lots of discussion. The Shapes Trilogy series inspired Shape Island from Apple TV+.







Every time a girl or boy makes a wish which break gender stereotypes, the fairy Rose leaves angrily, without fulfilling it.




# CHARLIE'S EYEGLASSES
