SUPERFREDDY



Whether it's a free falling plant pot or a cat stuck in a tree, SuperFreddy is always ready to save the day! But sometimes being a superhero can be overwhelming.



After the successful *The Flock*, Margarita del Mazo and Guridi return with another funny story. This time, with a team of pigs!




The pigs live happily and peacefully together but they can't help wondering why only sheep get to be counted by children trying to fall asleep. Why can't children count pigs instead?
